 - a. Water Sold Exhibit 1

Water sales for August 2024 are 20.8% higher than they were for August 2023. Year to date sales is 7.3% higher than this time in 2023.

Total revenues for 2024 are 29% higher than this time last year. Expenses are 10% higher than this time last year. There has been approximately \$938,000 in acquisition of service and water supply reliability fees this year. If we subtract this amount from the net income year-to-date, net income is approximately equal to 2023 year-to-date net income.

c. New Development Update

- 13th & Oak Glenn Installing12-inch water line to service the new hotel, carwash, gas station and restaurant being built.
- Artisan Homes on 17th Street Connection fees in the amount of \$215,457 were paid for the final phase on August 19. The total connection fees received for this project from 2022 to present is \$1,400,297. The development paid an additional \$81,000 in 2021 to upgrade the line on 17th Street.
- 11th & Yucaipa Blvd Storage New 12-inch line installed from Avenue D to Yucaipa Blvd.
- Raising Caines Offsite improvements to install an additional 400 feet of 12-inch on Yucaipa Blvd with be completed before the end of the year.
